Choose your Saint

Saints are witnesses of living a Christian life. Read about saints and choose three (1st, 2nd, 3rd choice) about whom you would like to learn more. You will turn in your choices to Mrs. Triggs, and you will be assigned one saint to study in detail.

Research (out of class)

Learn about your saint. Using books and the internet, learn about your saint's early life, how they served God and others, and their patronage.

Paragraph - "Why I Chose this Saint"

In this paragraph, tell:

- 1. The name of your saint.
- 2. Three reasons why you have chosen to study this saint.
- 3. How you would like to imitate this saint in your life.

Paragraphs and Information for project board

Using your research, write additional paragraphs focused on each of the following. Each paragraph must have at least 5 complete sentences.

- 1. Your saint's early life (childhood).
- 2. One significant event in the life of your saint.
- 3. A second significant event in the life of your saint.
- 4. How Christians today can imitate your saint.

Oral presentation

Your oral presentation will highlight your saint for our visitors at the Living Saints Museum. You should share who your saint is, the significant events of their life as a disciple of Christ, and how that saint is a witness to living a life of discipleship.

All Saints' Day Mass

On All Saint's Day, you will wear the costume you created for your saint. Our class will process into the Mass in costume as a community of saints. Your costume must also include two props which represent your saint.

Saint Project Board

Your saint project board will highlight key information about your saint. It must be a trifold presentation board which includes all requirements on the rubric. Neatness and attractiveness matter.

Living Saints' Museum

Present your saint to the school and visitors. While wearing your costume, you will share your project board and your oral presentation.
